## Cypark Resources bags RM28m worth of contracts

CYPARK Resources Bhd has secured three letter of awards from National Department of Solid Waste Management for works in Negri Sembilan and Pahang worth a total of RM28.47 million.

In an exchange filing yesterday, the integrated environmental engineering and technology provider noted that it will undertake the works for five years from April 3 this year in Nilai and Port Dickson, totalling RM12.15 million and RM11.37 million respectively.

The company will also enter works in Kuantan for a two-year period starting on April 3, 2017, and totalling RM4.95 million.

Cypark added that the awards are in the best interest of the company and are expected to contribute positively to its earnings.

It concluded that the contracts will not have any effect on its share capital of substantial shareholders' shareholdings.
