YB TAN SRI NOH BIN HAJI OMAR VISITED CYPARK'S SMART WASTE TO ENERGY PROJECT

Port Dickson, Negeri Sembilan, - Minister of Urban Well-being, Housing and Local Government , YB Tan Sri Noh Bin Haji Omar today visited Cypark SMART Waste To Energy Project located at Ladang Tanah Merah, Port Dickson, Negeri Sembilan Darul Khusus

The Cypark's Solid Waste Modular Advanced Recovery and Treatment System (SMART) project is developed by Cypark Resources Berhad on 70 hectares of land. The project which is expected to be completed by 2018 has the power installed capacity up to 25 MWh. It is an integrated waste management solution that provides both effective and clear target to divert recoverable and recyclable waste.

SMART WTE project is the nation's pioneering project featuring Total Waste Management Solutions; diverting less than 20 percent of waste from being sent to landfill. The SMART WTE project brings together the Waste Segregation Facility (WSF), Fully Anaerobic Bioreactor System (FABIOS) and Waste to Energy Plant (WTE) as integrated cluster of intermediate solid waste treatment facilities, with each of them performing their respective function and compliment each other, thereby extending the lifespan of a landfill while saving about 50 hectares of land from landfill development over the next 25 years.

Tan Sri Razali Ismail, Executive Chairman of Cypark Resources Berhad and Dato' Daud Ahmad, Group Chief Executive Officer of Cypark Resources Berhad were at the site to welcome the minister and his delegates.
