

Kerjaya bags RM103m Penang jobs, order book expands to RM4.4b



KERJAYA Prospek Group Bhd secured two construction contracts worth a combined RM102.6 million for projects on Andaman Island, Penang, lifting its outstanding order book to RM4.4 billion and providing earnings visibility for the next one to two years.

The contracts were awarded to its wholly owned subsidiary Kerjaya Prospek (M) Sdn Bhd by Persada Mentari Sdn Bhd, an 80%-owned unit of Eastern & Oriental Bhd.

The larger RM69.6 million contract involves building 28 three-storey terrace houses and 18 three-storey semi-detached houses, while the RM33.01 million job covers piling and earthworks for a 53-storey serviced apartment project at Bandar Tanjung Pinang.

The latest wins came a day after Kerjaya secured a RM174.2 million contract from an IJM Land unit, bringing total new contract wins in May to RM276.8 million and cumulative wins for FY2026 to RM1.1 billion. — **TMR**
