

Kerjaya Prospek Posted 24% Rise In 1Q PATAMI To RM57 Million, Declared 3.5 sen Dividend



Kerjaya Prospek Group Berhad announced its results for the first quarter of the financial year ending 31 December 2026 with profit after tax and minority interest rising 24.5% year-on-year to RM57.3 million, on the back of revenue of RM446.8 million.

The construction segment contributed RM378.4 million in revenue, while the property development segment revenue recorded a 38.5% increase to RM68.0 million, mainly driven by sales recognition from The Vue @ Montereze and Papyrus @ North Kiara.

Kerjaya declared a first interim single-tier dividend of 3.5 sen per share in respect of FY2026, amounting to RM44.0 million. The dividend represents a payout ratio of 76.8% of the Group's PATAMI and will be payable on 30 June 2026. The trailing twelve months dividend per share implies a yield of 6.3%, based on the current share price of RM2.07.
