

Kerjaya Prospek bags RM858m data centre job

KUALA LUMPUR: Kerjaya Prospek Group Bhd's wholly-owned subsidiary, Kerjaya Prospek (M) Sdn Bhd, has secured its first data centre contract worth RM858 million, marking a significant milestone in the group's expansion into the high-growth data centre sector.

Chief executive officer and executive director Tee Eng Tiong said the sizable RM858 million contract marked an important milestone for Kerjaya as the company made its foray into the data centre sector.

"We view this project as a strong starting point to establish our presence in the data centre space.

"Beyond the immediate contribution to our order book, the project will further enhance our capabilities, execution track record and industry expertise, positioning us to pursue a broader range of opportunities within this high-growth sector," he said in a statement.

The latest contract win brings Kerjaya's total new contract wins for 2026 to RM3.2 billion, further strengthening Kerjaya's earnings visibility and construction pipeline. "Our outstanding order book has reached a record RM5.9 billion, providing a strong foundation for sustained revenue contribution over the coming years," Tee noted.

In a filing to Bursa Malaysia, Kerjaya said the contract will commence in the third quarter of 2026 and will be completed within eight months from the commencement date. —Bernama
