

Kerjaya Prospek lands maiden data centre job worth RM858mil

KUALA LUMPUR: Kerjaya Prospek Group Bhd's unit Kerjaya Prospek (M) Sdn Bhd has secured an RM858 million contract for fit-out works at a data centre in Johor.

In a filing with Bursa Malaysia, the company said the contract involves the execution and completion of mechanical, electrical and plumbing fit-out works for the project, which is expected to commence in the third quarter.

The project is targeted for completion within eight months.

Kerjaya chief executive officer and executive director Tee Eng Tiong said the award marked an important milestone for the company in the data centre sector.

"We view this project as a strong starting point to establish our presence in the data centre space.

"Beyond the immediate contribution to our order book, the project will further enhance our capabilities, execution track record and industry expertise, positioning us to pursue a broader range of opportunities within this high-growth sector," he said.

The latest win brings the group's total new contract wins for 2026 to RM3.2 billion, further strengthening its earnings visibility and construction pipeline.

"Meanwhile, our outstanding order book has reached a record RM5.9 billion, providing a strong foundation for sustained revenue contribution over the coming years," Tee said.

At the midday break, Kerjaya Prospek's share price rose 3.12 per cent, or nine sen, to RM2.97, valuing the company at RM3.76 billion.
