

Kerjaya Prospek bags first data centre contract

KUALA LUMPUR: Construction outfit Kerjaya Prospek Group Bhd has secured its first data centre contract worth RM858 million, marking a significant milestone in the group's expansion into the high-growth data centre sector.

The contract was awarded to its wholly owned subsidiary, Kerjaya Prospek (M) Sdn Bhd, by a data centre developer and comprises mechanical, electrical and plumbing (MEP) fit-out works for a data centre located in Iskandar Puteri, Johor.

The project is expected to commence in Q3 of 2026 and is targeted for completion within eight months.

Kerjaya CEO and executive director Tee Eng Tiong said the group is pleased to secure this sizable RM858 million contract, marking an important milestone as it makes its foray into the data centre sector.

"We view this project as a strong starting point to establish our presence in the data centre space.

"Beyond the immediate contribution to our order book, the project will further enhance our capabilities, execution track record and industry expertise, positioning us to pursue a broader range of opportunities within this high-growth sector.

"This latest win brings our total new contract wins for 2026 to RM3.2 billion, further strengthening Kerjaya's earnings visibility and construction pipeline.

"Meanwhile, our outstanding order book has reached a record RM5.9 billion, providing a strong foundation for sustained revenue contribution over the coming years," he said.
